There are more than 100 countries (known as visa citizens) whose residents need visas to get to the UK even as tourists, but the US is not one of them. Americans can come to the four countries in the region – England, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales – without a visa and stay for up to six months at a time. Although continental Europeans have historically been able to stay in the UK for as long as they want – to live, work and study for a whole life, even – Brexit has changed things. Britain's departure from the European Union (EU) means that UK residents can require a visa to visit EU countries for more than a month and vice versa. Follow developments here. While Brexit may have halted free movement between the UK and Europe's Schengen area, these changes will have little effect on American travellers. Unlike some people from some countries, Americans, Canadians and Australians do not need tourist visas to travel in the UK for up to six months because they have a passport valid for the duration of their stay (or be safe for six full months). The UK offers 48-hour transit visas for long lay-offs, six-month visiting visas for visa citizens, student visas, work visas and family visas for parents, prospectual partners and spouses of UK citizens, all of which are Gov.UK. You can usually apply for and pay for your visa online, but you have to do so from outside the UK. Alternatively, you can apply for a visa from the UK Visa Centre in your country. Free entry, usually up to six months, is granted when you show a valid passport to a UK immigration officer at the airport. You may be asked about the nature of your visit to ensure that you meet the country's immigration rules. This applies to citizens of most (not all) South American and Caribbean countries, as well as Japan. If you come from any country with more than 100 visas, have a criminal record or have been refused entry to the UK in the past, you will probably need to obtain a standard visitor visa before you leave. This visa can be used not only for leisure, but also for short-term business or medical care. A UK visitor visa lasts six months and costs £95 (about \$120)To apply, you will need a passport valid for the duration of your stay, travel dates and details, an estimate of how much your trip will cost, proof of income, contact details and your parents' names and birthdays. You can't work on a visitor visa, but you can study for up to 30 days as long as it's not the primary reason for visiting. The earliest you can apply for is three months before your trip. It takes about three weeks to process. If you are travelling to receive medical treatment, you can extend your visa to 11 months for a fee of \$239 (190 euros). You can extend a standard visitor visa to a long-term visitor visa by £361 for two years, £655 for five years or £822 for 10 years. Remember that a UK tourist visa does not grant access to the EU. Only visitors to the Schengen area (to which the UK does not belong) can travel freely without border controls. UK work visas fall into two categories: short-term (level 5) and long-term (level 2). To get a work visa to the UK, you must be a skilled employee and already have a job offer from a licensed sponsor. You usually apply for a long-term visa through your employer, who must give you a sponsorship certificate in order to start working. A Tier 2 universal work visa usually allows stays of up to five years and 14 days and costs £610 for up to three years and £1,220 for more than three years. You have to apply outside the UK. You can also bring family members with you for an additional fee. Temporary agency workers are sometimes granted visas (level 5) for charitable workers, religious workers, creative workers and seasonal workers. They cost £244 (about \$315) and allow a year's stay. Other special visas may be issued to entrepreneurs and innovators. For more information on employment in the UK, visit the employment visa page of the immigration website. If the reason for your visit to the UK is studying, you can do so on a short-term study visa (6-11 months, not for publicly funded studies), a Tier 4 general student visa for longer university studies or a Tier 4 child student visa Children between the ages of 4 and 17. All students except children must also pay a health care surcharge (about \$200 per year of study) when applying. It costs £1,523 to become a family member if you apply outside the UK, or £1,033 if you apply from the UK. Partners and spouses must be married or prove that they have lived together for two years. All partners and spouses shall provide evidence of the relationship by photographs and other documents. The information varies depending on whether you are a parent, child or partner, but you can find certain eligibility requirements and information on the family visa Gov.UK. It will take up to 12 weeks to get a decision when you apply outside the UK, or up to eight weeks if you apply from the UK. Visa citizens must obtain a transit visa when staying in the UK for less than 48 hours. You need to show travel information, such as airline bookings, when you apply. Overs overscoring a visa in the UK can be considered a crime that can justify deportation and imprisonment, although the latter consequence is not very common. You have a 14-day extension after the visa expires to leave the area, but if you are more than 90 days or more, you can be banned from the UK for at least a year. Most UK visas can be extended for a variety of reasons, but it can cost an additional fee and should be done in the UK. For example, family visas usually have to be extended every two and a half years. After living in the United Kingdom full-time for five years, the visa holder can obtain an indefinite residence permit You can apply for a family visa extension online for about \$1,300, but you still have to meet the original requirements of your visa. If your home country is in the European Union and you want to stay in the UK after Brexit, you may be entitled to an EU reconciliation system with a deadline of 30 June 2021. Student and work visas can usually only be extended that you continue or start a new job or study with a certified sponsor in the UK. In the case of a tourist visa, you can only apply for an extension if your total period in the UK is up to six months (for example, if your original visa was only valid for three months, you can apply for a residence permit for a further three months).
